

The Molly H. Glander Memorial Undergraduate Research Grant

The Molly H. Glander Memorial Undergraduate Research Grant was established at the Duke University Primate Center to encourage and support involvement of undergraduate students in research projects at the Center.

Grants are awarded to Duke University undergraduate students who are engaged in an approved research project at the Center. Eligible students must have an approved protocol, a submitted protocol, or must be approved to work under an approved professor's protocol.

- A one time award of \$200.00 - \$300.00 to be used in a single semester.
- Funding will cover DUPC research fees, project supplies and/or equipment.

Application Process:

Applications are available through the DUPC Research Assistant 489-3364 ext.222, stephanie.combes@duke.edu, and are posted in the main entrance of the DUPC. Please submit completed grant applications with advisor statement of support to the DUPC Research Assistant. **Applications are due by 12 Noon on the last day of drop/add.** Applications will be reviewed by a grant review committee during the week following drop/add, and applicants will then be notified within a week of their award status.

Each award recipient is required to submit a short research summary/ progress report of their project to the DUPC at the end of the semester. If students wish to apply for new funding, or renew their funding, they are required to submit a new application as well as include a brief statement of previous work for which other grants were awarded.

Application Evaluation:

1. Applications will be reviewed for undergraduate student projects only.
2. Applications will be evaluated on merit of research by a review committee.
3. Applicants must have a submitted protocol or an approved research protocol at the DUPC.
4. Applications must be clear and complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
5. Applications must include an Advisor's statement of support and signatures.
6. Applications must be submitted no later than 12 Noon on the last day of drop add for the intended award semester.
