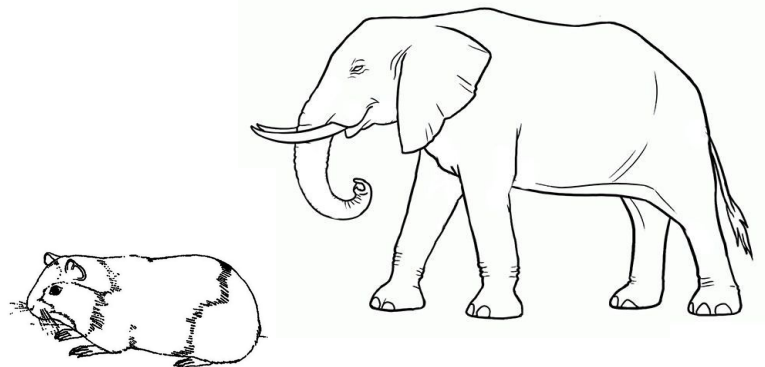
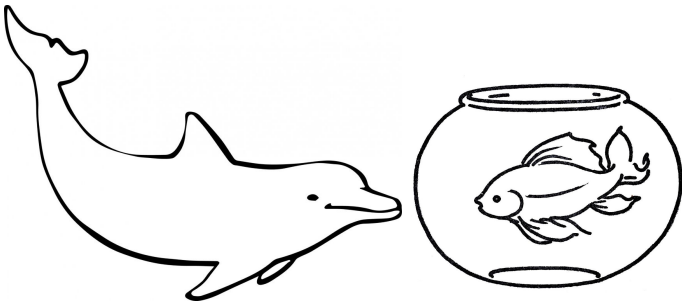
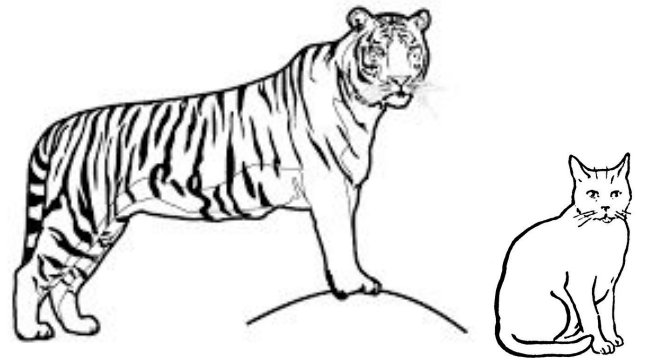
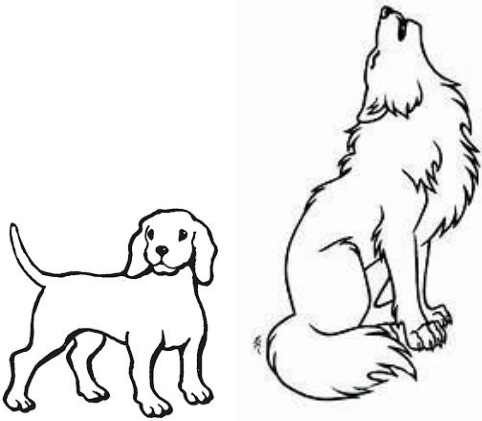


WHAT'S WILD?


These animals are grouped in pairs of one pet and one wild. Circle the **WILD** animal in each pair.




WHAT'S WILD?
